- 3. Create up to nearly 1 million jobs across the economy and protect U.S. workers;
- 4. Prioritize disadvantaged communities with grants and additional support;
- 5. Expand funding for technical assistance to small, rural and indigenous communities;
- 6. Fund projects to address water contamination from per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS);
- 7. Dedicate and increase grants for indigenous communities;
- 8. Upgrade household wells and septic systems;
- 9. Help homeowners replace lead service lines; and

10. Provide more than \$1 billion a year to update water infrastructure in public schools.
